Terms & Conditions 2007 Crop

- 1. Payment terms are between grower and packer, however, final and full payment shall be made no later than 7/31/08 unless extended by prior written agreement between PBA, member, and packer.*
- 2. Undersize screen is 24/32"*
- 3. No deducts for substandard if lot is standard on door test basis.*
- 4. Handler service fee is \$2.00 per salable ton on member tons only.*
- 5. Membership dues are \$8.00 per salable ton.*
- 6. Copy of member settlement and member P-1 gradesheets provided to PBA.*
